- Social behavior is directly observable

### 2. Importance of Classroom Rules

- Listening
  - Ability to sit and listen quietly
  - Ability to listen/participate in class discussion

### 3. Following Rules

- Recognizing the importance of classroom rules
- Following oral directions
- Following instructional directions
- Following clean-up directions

### 4. Self Control

- Remembering to walk, not run in the classroom and in the school
- Using a moderate tone of voice

### 5. Sharing

- Understanding the need for sharing with others

### 6. Accepting Consequences

- Knowing and accepting the consequences of our actions
